

## Where were they found?

Tyrannosaurus rex fossils have been found in **western North America**, within the United States and Canada.

The first, partial fossil was discovered in 1900 in eastern Wyoming, while the first significant specimen was unearthed in 1902 in Montana.



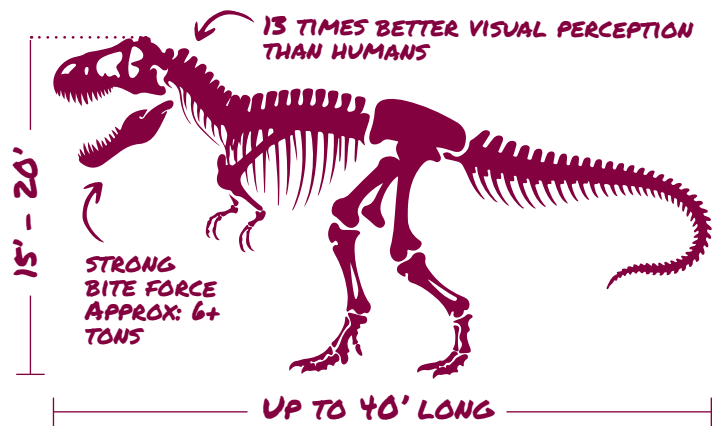
# T-Rex

*Tyrannosaurus Rex*

T.rex are **extinct carnivorous predators** that lived during the **very end of the Late Cretaceous Period**, approximately 68 to 66 million years ago.

T. rex had a lifespan of only **30 years**.

## What did they look like?

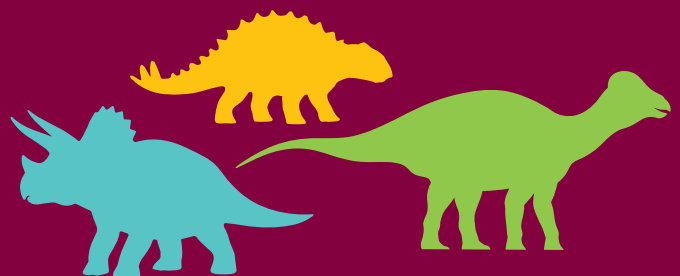


### Fun Facts!

## What did they eat?

Tyrannosaurus rexes were **massive carnivores and apex predators** that primarily ate large herbivores like **triceratops, edmontosaurus,** and **ankylosaurus**.
